This symposium will be organized by the Spanish Open Dialogue Network, a team of over 30 researchers and practitioners, and cover various topics on the experience in the implementation of open dialogue in Spanish-speaking countries. Testimonials will be given by the Unidad de Atención Temprana Joven del Hospital Universitario Príncipe de Asturias in Alcalá de Henares, Madrid, and the Centro de Atención de Salud Mental de Badalona II, Barcelona, the two projects with the longest track record in adopting the practice within the Spanish health system. Also participating will be members of the non-profit non-governmental organization La Porvenir, who offer care services based on open dialogue with peers from outside the mental health services. They will also discuss the training available, the perception of the practice by users, family members and society in general, and the different problems we face in extending the model throughout the territory. Future plans and opportunities to be developed will be discussed.
